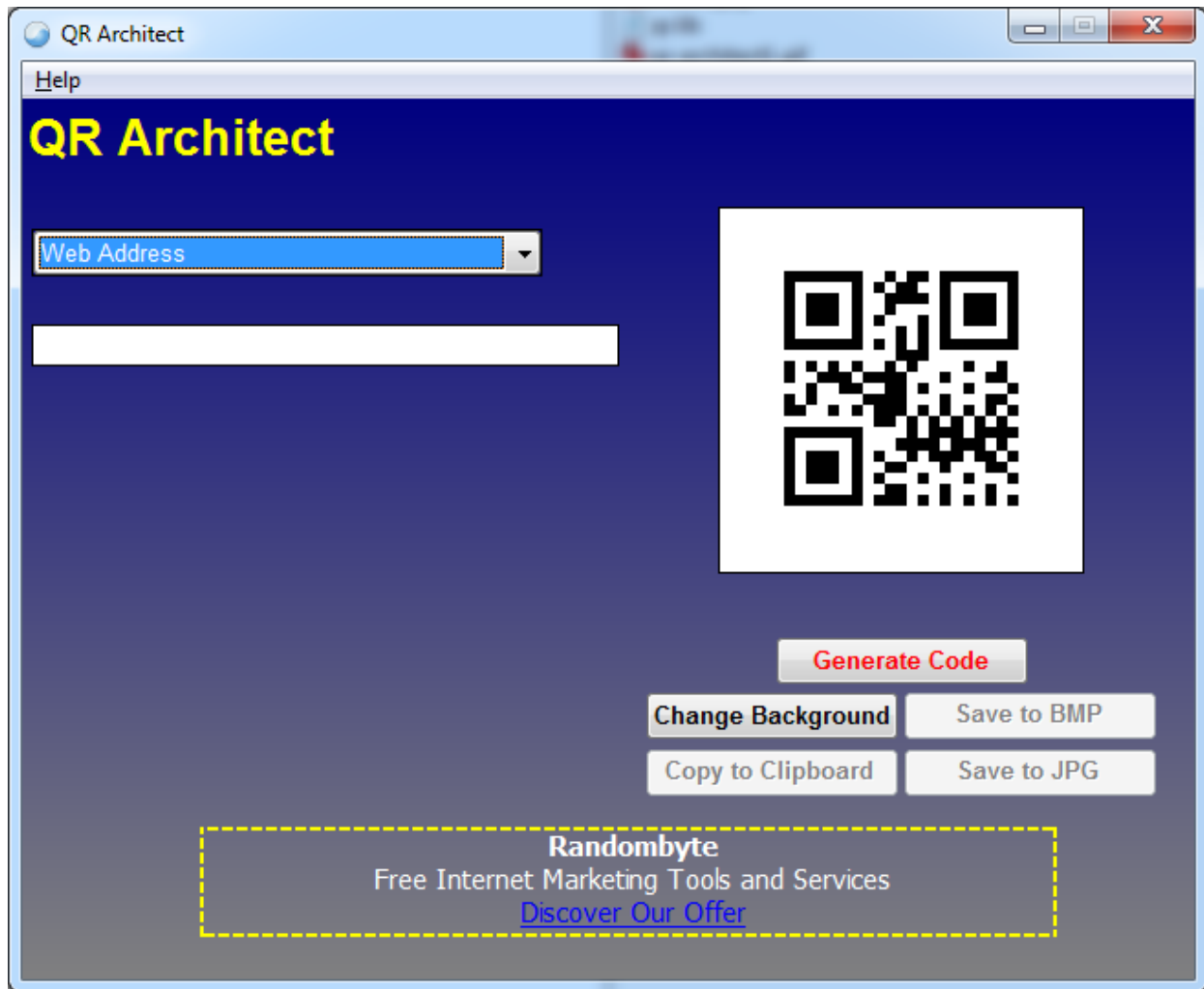
Thank you for downloading QR Architect! It is a useful application that can create a variety of QR codes for your websites, email addresses, phone numbers, geographic locations, etc.

The generated codes can be used online, can be incorporated in printed materials, can be used for flyers and so on, allowing anyone to find out more about you and your business without having to write down or remember complicated web addresses, phone numbers, etc.

For those of you that haven't used QR codes until now, it is important to know that QR stands for Quick Response – these codes are nothing more than square bar codes that can send many potential customers to your website, phone number, email address, etc.

All the modern cell phones can use QR applications, reading the codes and then opening the corresponding web address, telephone number, email program or geographical location automatically.

The self extracting archive contains 3 files: QR Architect.exe (the actual program), qr.lib (a library needed by the program) and manual.pdf, the document that you are reading right now. Run QR Architect.exe and you will see the main program interface.



Click the "Web Address" field to select one of the supported formats:

- Web addresses
- Email addresses
- SMS numbers
- Phone numbers
- Plain text
- Geographic locations
- ME cards
- Android Marketplace codes
- Wi-Fi configurations.

Let's use the "Web Address" format as an example: select it from the drop-down list if it isn't already selected, and then type in the desired address in the field below it, the way you want it to appear in your website visitors' browsers – here's an example:



Click the "Generate Code" button; the QR code is going to be created immediately. Save the code to JPG, and then upload the resulting image to your website, or copy it to the clipboard, and then paste it into your favorite graphic editor. You can also change the background color; please be aware that if the contrast isn't big enough, some of the QR scanners will fail to read the code, rendering it useless.

If you've got a modern cell phone you will definitely find a free QR scanner for it, no matter if you have an iPhone, an Android-based phone, etc. Install the QR scanner (if your phone doesn't include one already), start it, and then point your phone towards the screen; if everything works as planned you will see that your phone prompts you to open the desired website address. This step is optional; you don't need a smart phone in order to use QR Architect.
